The School of Civil and Construction Engineering invites applications for a full-time, 9-month, 1.0 FTE, tenure track position in Geomatics Engineering, expected to be filled for Fall 2009, though earlier appointments will be considered. The position is expected to be filled at the Assistant Professor level; however, outstanding candidates at the Associate or Full Professor level will also be considered. Hire with tenure requires candidates' dossier to be successfully reviewed by P&T committee and Office of Academic Affairs.

The successful candidate will demonstrate ability in the area of Geomatics Engineering (digital imaging systems, sensor technology, positioning, and wireless location) with strong applications in civil and construction engineering, including interest in natural hazard mitigation and infrastructure construction/monitoring.

Requires a PhD or terminal degree or PhD by date of employment in Civil and Construction Engineering or closely related discipline, demonstrated ability to teach graduate and undergraduate courses, and develop a research program in the academic discipline/unit. The candidate should be qualified to teach graduate courses in his or her area of specialization, as well as undergraduate courses in civil engineering or construction engineering management. To be considered at the Associate Professor or Professor level, the candidate must have research experience and publications commensurate with these levels to be granted the same rank at Oregon State University.

The successful candidate is expected to develop and sustain a high-quality, sponsored research program that would involve Ph.D. and M.S. student researchers, and engage in interdisciplinary research with faculty within CCE and in other academic units at OSU, including College of Forestry, College of Oceanic and Atmospheric Sciences, and the College of Science. In addition, he or she is expected to teach and advise graduate and undergraduate students in the School of Civil and Construction Engineering.
